Field Work for the Design of Berford St., Gould St., Pengally Ave., Elm St., Brown St., Mary St., Division St. & William St. Streetscape and Servicing Improvements in the Town of Wiarton, South Bruce Peninsula

The Town of South Bruce Peninsula has entered into a contract with R.J. Burnside & Associates Limited (Consulting Professional Engineers) for the reconstruction of various streets in the Town of Wiarton within the limits as noted on the map The work generally consists of the below. replacement of storm and sanitary sewers and services, watermain and water services, sidewalk, curb and gutter, etc., as required. The roads will also be improved through changes in road base materials, asphalt and possibly vertical and horizontal alignments. Berford Street will be fully reconstructed including streetscaping improvements, street lighting and traffic signal upgrades as outlined in the Town's approved Wiarton Streetscape Design Concept (2016).

Field work such as topographic and legal surveys, geotechnical investigations, underground utility locates and other work necessary for the design of the works is expected to start late-July and completed mid-September 2019.

R.J. Burnside & Associates Limited and its sub-consultants will be on-site performing many of the above noted tasks within the Town right-of-way. Except for some non-invasive topographic survey, work is not expected to encroach onto private property.

R.J. Burnside & Associates Limited and its sub-consultants are committed to provide the necessary signage and traffic control to maintain pedestrian and motorist safety and mobility.

Will I Have Access To My Home Or Business?

Yes, R.J. Burnside & Associates Limited and its sub-consultants will maintain access to your home and business at all times. Clear unobstructed entrances shall be maintained to all dwellings and businesses. Emergency vehicular access will also be maintained at all times.

How Will My Services Be Affected?

Telephone, hydro, water, cable TV, sewer and gas services should not be affected by the field work, barring any unforeseen circumstances.

Safety

R.J. Burnside & Associates Limited and its sub-consultants are required to conduct the work in a safe manner including delineation, if required, of the work area, etc. We ask that you take extra caution during the geotechnical investigation phase of the works as a drilling machine will be drilling for soil samples and one lane of traffic may be affected. The Geotechnical sub-consultant will provide safety and traffic control measures to ensure everyone's safety.
